Virtual Youth Consultation on Ocean Sustainability

Background

The World Food Forum (WFF)'s Global Youth Action Initiative aims to empower youth to drive agrifood systems transformation through year-round thematic programmes. Central to this work is the Youth Assembly, a platform where young people, through consultations and action, shape solutions for sustainable agrifood systems.

Fisheries and aquaculture have become a key focus of the Youth Assembly, leading to the creation of a global Youth Constituency that gathers diverse perspectives and supports youth-led innovations in sustainable aquatic food systems.

In the lead-up to the 2026 Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) Committee on Fisheries (COFI37), The Youth Assembly will soon launch a series of consultations to ensure voices of young fishers, fish farmers and fish workers across the value chain are included in critical discussions on sector challenges and solutions.

The first consultation will take place on 20 May 2025, marking the beginning of the consultation process. The outcomes will contribute to shaping key messages and outputs for the side event organized by FAO at the 2025 United Nations Ocean Conference: "From legacy to leadership: Youth-led solutions for ocean sustainability".

This event, celebrating FAO's 80th anniversary, will contribute to elevating and strengthening the voice of youth in decision-making processes related to the sector.

The virtual consultation and the event will be the first of several steps towards COFI37, forming a roadmap designed to strengthen youth participation in shaping the future of sustainable, productive and resilient aquatic food systems.

Throughout this process, the Youth Constituency on Fisheries and Aquaculture will play a central role in mobilizing young stakeholders, collecting regional inputs and co-developing policy recommendations.

Proposal and objectives

The virtual consultation will convene youth and young professionals working in fisheries and aquaculture to shape collective positions, solutions and recommendations. These outcomes will

inform the side event at the UN Ocean Conference.

Key objectives include:

Identify youth-driven priorities, challenges and solutions within the following thematic

Data and science;

Capacity development; and

Effective management.

Co-develop actionable recommendations that will inform the youth-led outcome

statement for the side event, contributing to the broader Youth Assembly process.

Strengthen youth networks and engagement mechanisms, ensuring sustained

momentum and coordinated efforts across different youth-led realities in fisheries and

aquaculture
