

Agrifood Leadership Education Programme on Young Women's Empowerment Written Proposal Template

Applicants are required to submit a short-written proposal presenting an advocacy idea that addresses a specific challenge faced by young women in agrifood systems. The proposal must clearly describe the issue being targeted, explain how youth can contribute to the solution and indicate how the applicant can draw on their current role (through work, studies, or volunteer experience) to implement the project. Each proposal must include a training or education component, which means that every project should offer a learning opportunity for youth and help them replicate or disseminate the knowledge gained throughout the programme.

The proposal must not exceed 400 words in total and must be completed directly in the sections provided below.

Name and surname
Country and National Chapter
Issue to be addressed (max. 100 words) Briefly describe the specific <u>challenge</u> young women face in agrifood systems that your project aims to tackle. Focus on explaining the problem, why it matters and who is affected.
Proposed advocacy idea (max. 100 words) Describe your proposed advocacy approach to address the issue mentioned above and explain the potential training and/or education activities that will be included in your project.

Expected outcomes (max. 100 words)

Briefly describe the intended change or impact of your advocacy idea.

Your contribution and current role (max. 100 words)

Explain how your current work, studies, or volunteer experience will help you carry out the initiative.
